Hello West Park Bilingual Families!

We are busy preparing to kick off the 2025-2026 school year! In order to maintain our professional learning environment and for continuous learning to take place without uniform violations we need your help! All students are expected to be in full uniform by the first day of school, Monday August 18<sup>th</sup>. Please ensure that your child arrives ready to learn in full uniform daily.

Dress Code: (This can also be found in the Student and Family Handbook)

**a. Shirt**

**i. Navy, white or orange polo shirt (long or short sleeve) with or without school logo**

1. Parents can purchase WPBA polo shirts at school. School will place orders upon request.
2. Undergarments must also be solid colored navy, white or orange (e.g., t-shirts)

**ii. Navy, white or orange sweatshirt**

1. Sweatshirts with school logo can be purchased at school.
2. No logos other than the school logo will be allowed.

**b. Pant, Short & Skirt**

**i. Khaki, Black or Navy**

- ii. All shorts or skirts need to be within two inches of the knee.
- iii. Pants/shorts/skirts should be in good repair without excessive tears or holes.
- iv. No jeans, sweatpants, overalls, leggings, or jeggings. No colored denim.

**c. Shoes**

**i. Close-toed tennis or dress shoes**

- ii. No open-toed sandals, high heels, flip-flops, slides, "wheelies" or crocs are allowed due to safety concerns.
- iii. Socks or tights must be worn at all times.

**2. Prohibited Items Students are under no circumstances allowed to:**

- a. "Sag" their pants. Brown or black belts may be worn to avoid this.
- b. Hoods/hats should not be worn in public spaces during school.
- c. Wear "yoga" pants or tights as pants even on dress down days.
- d. headscarves (except for religious observance).
- e. Wear writing or pictures on any clothing.
- f. Wear see-through clothing of any kind.
